Award Description

Pearls of Service Incorporated in partnership with Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Incorporated®, Eta Alpha Omega Chapter of Rock Hill, SC, is awarding an HBCU scholarship in the 2021-2022 school year. The scholarship may go toward studies at an accredited four-year Historically Black College or University.

The HBCU for Life and Scholarship Committee will award financial assistance to two students majoring in health, business, or the arts (preferably but not limited to those majors). Each recipient will receive a \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship. All scholarships will be paid directly to the institution.

Eligibility and Requirements

To qualify for the HBCU for Life scholarship student must:

- Reside in York or Chester Counties of South Carolina.
- Be a female or male rising sophomore, junior, or senior, with a 2.8 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Be a full-time student attending a Historically Black College/University.
- Attach your most recent transcript.
- Provide 500-word personal statement.
- One letter of recommendation.

Disbursement

Disbursement of scholarship monies will be sent to the college or university. Funds for scholarship must be requested by September 30, 2021. After this date, scholarship funds will no longer be available for disbursement.
